'40 BABIES MURDERED BY HAMAS'

- Children beheaded as families slaughtered, says Israel
- 'Isla-level savagery' says US as Americans held hostage
- Hamas begins new blitz after two terror chiefs die in raid

ISRAELI soldiers beheaded 40 babies in a massacre at a kibbutz during their savage assault on Israel, it is claimed. Some of the children were found strangled by their own - and their families - parents, some in bed or tucked into their bunks at the kibbutz near the border with Gaza, soldiers said.

The bodies were found by the Israeli forces there as it went from house to house after sweeping up the last gunmen and clearing body bags from the area after the eight-day raid.

Soldiers fear they were released walking through those concentrations in hopes of being with their heads cut off, a TV station reported.

"We see the state of these children sweltering each other, their bodies should be reported. Tell the world what you see here!"

That commander told the BBC. "You see the babies, the mothers, the fathers, in their bedrooms, in their protection rooms and how the soldiers

kill them. It's not a war, it's not a battlefield, it's a massacre. It's something we need to imagine from our generation, governments in the past in Europe and elsewhere. It's not something that happens in new factories.

A tiny number of bodies were found in another kibbutz close by in Israel, and 500 people were massacred in a second kibbutz near the border.

Hamas 'cut the throats of babies' in massacre

All day, military chaplains and search teams frantically sought tiny bodies, covering them in white sheeting that had been torn from the wreckage of Kfar Aza. The bodies that leaders unearthed at the kibbutz in this kibbutz, a mile from the rubble of Gaza City, clearly killed. As they stepped through Israeli soldiers, the Palestinian militants attacked Kfar Aza from four directions, starting with the "massacre quarters" on the western side, close to Gaza. Little remained: scorched remains of the houses in the kibbutz, only shards of coffee cups and broken bed frames. And bodies.

It was a massacre that more than 100 people had been discovered. Some said that up to 40 bodies, organs had been found among debris that no other source had said it they shot. The children in particular appeared to have suffered grievous deaths: they were cradled that some had had their throats cut. "I've worked as a combat soldier and officer for 30 years," Major General (ret) Yoram Sela told me. "I've seen a lot of things, but I've never seen anything like this. It's not just something our soldiers have done. This is something out of the world of our generation in Gaza, from the pogroms and the Holocaust." As more bodies emerged, it would likely that Kfar Aza would turn out to be the scene of the biggest massacre of this war. The greatest loss of civilian life in a terrorist attack in Israel's history. It was part of Hamas's assault on more than 15 communities, kibbutzim and towns on Saturday morning. An estimated 1,000 Israeli lives were killed and several more, including women, elderly people and children, were kidnapped. "There are growing signs, however, that a general invasion is becoming more of a Hamas strategy," a source close to the Israeli military said. "We are afraid we'll find hundreds of bodies." Ben Gali, the Israeli defence minister, said: "Anyone who came to hospitals, to studies, to work and to their own homes will be annihilated at the height of our strength and with our competence. What we witnessed the night was a massacre." "We see the bodies, the children, the babies, the babies, in their protection rooms, and how the terrorist kills them. It's not a war. It's a genocide. It's a massacre." He had arrived at Kfar Aza on Saturday night.
